Free Immunization Clinics for Grades 6th-12th

In 2009, the Indiana State Legislature revised the Indiana code to require all 6th through 12th grade public, charter or private school students to receive additional immunizations against the following diseases:

- Meningitis
- Varicella (Chicken pox)
- Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis (Whooping cough))

Students must be vaccinated against all three by the first day of the 2010 school year. To assist families with immunizing their children and to better accommodate the large number of students in 6th through 12th grades, the Grant County Health Department will be offering these vaccines during extended hours at the Five Points Mall. The free vaccines will be given in the Community Room during various times from now through the beginning of school. You may also choose to schedule an appointment with your family Physician. We believe if we begin to immunize now; we will minimize the chaos in August!

Our Schedule in the Community Room at the Five Points Mall will be as follows:

- April 7th - 3:00 to 7:00 PM
- May 5th - 3:00 to 7:00 PM
- June 9th - 1:00 to 6:00 PM
- July 14th - 1:00 to 6:00 PM
- July 28th - 1:00 to 6:00 PM
- August 4th - 1:00 to 6:00 PM
- August 5th - 1:00 to 6:00 PM
- August 6th - 1:00 to 6:00 PM

Parents will need to bring their child's shot record and child must be accompanied by parent or legal guardian.
