

## **BUS STUDENTS**

Students should enter the building immediately after exiting from the bus. Bus transportation is a privilege—not a right. Proper conduct on the busses is expected at all times. Bus drivers have the responsibility for appropriate student behavior on busses. Drivers may report any unacceptable behavior to the proper school authorities. Unacceptable behavior may result in suspension from riding the bus for a period of time.

## **RULES FOR PUPILS WHO RIDE THE BUS**

School bus drivers are to have control of all school children transported between the homes of the children and school. The driver shall keep order, maintain discipline among the children while in the bus or along the route, treat all the children in a civil manner, see that no child is imposed upon or mistreated while in his/her charge, and use every care for the safety of the children under his/her charge. School bus drivers shall assure that the following regulations are observed by all passengers;

- A. Each pupil shall be located immediately upon entering the bus in the place assigned by the driver.
- B. No pupils shall stand or move from place to place during the trip.
- C. Loud, boisterous, or profane language, or indecent conduct shall not be tolerated.
- D. Pupils shall not be allowed to tease, scuffle, trip, hold, hit, or use their hands or body in any other objectionable manner.
- E. No windows or doors will be opened or closed except by permission of the bus driver.
- F. No pupils shall enter or leave the bus until it has come to a full stop and the door has been opened by the driver.
- G. The child should be waiting at his/her boarding station when the school bus arrives. In case of an emergency causing late arrival by the pupil at his/her station, the bus driver will be required to wait no longer than three (3) minutes after the scheduled time for arrival at the student station. If the school bus driver is already three (3) minutes late, he/she need not wait at all.
- H. **Upon recommendation of the bus driver, school authorities will deny the privilege of riding on the school bus to any pupil who refused to conduct himself or herself in a gentlemanly or lady-like manner on the bus.**
